



"Fewer women in the boardroom"

The glass ceiling is slipping further from reach, as new research shows the proportion of women serving as non-executive directors fell over the last 12 months. Men continue to hold the overwhelmingly majority of non-executive positions on the country's top boards, the 2010 Board of Directors Study by corporate advisers Egan Associates.
